Notes to Structure of B. Com. Programme

1. English & Marathi are allowed medium of instruction for the courses.
2. For course no.5 & 6 at First Year, course no.5 & 6 at Second Year & Course No.3, 5 at Third Year there shall be Practicals of 20 marks in each course. Similarly for course no. 7 at Third Year there shall be an option of project report of 50 marks to the students.
3. For all the courses,(except course no.5 &6 at First Year and Second Year & Course No.3, and 7 at Third Year) there shall be an annual pattern of examination of 100 marks comprising of external examination of 80 marks & Continuous internal assessment of 20 marks each.
 - a. For Course no.6 at First Year, Course no.6 at Second Year & Course No. 5 at Third Year, the existing system of assessment for 20 marks' practical portion shall continue. The marks obtained by the student out of these 20 marks shall be taken as final score for the internal assessment portion under 80-20 pattern.
 - b. For course no.5 at First Year, course no.5 at Second Year & Course No.3 at Third Year, the total mark allocation shall be 40 marks for first course and 60 marks for the second co-course. Out of 60 marks for the computer course 20 marks are for practical & 40marks for theory. Out of these 40 marks 10 marks for internal assessment and 30 marks for annual examination. The Practicals examination of 20 marks for the computer portion shall be conducted as per the existing system of assessment. For theory portion of the co- courses of 40 marks there shall be 10 marks for internal assessment and 30 marks for annual examination as per the 80-20 pattern rules. The Annual Theory examination paper shall be of 60 marks comprising 30 marks for each co-course.

- c. At Third Year for Course No. 7 Student can offer the Project Report of 100 Marks or opt to appear for Theory Paper of 100 Marks as per 80: 20 Patterns. In case the Students opts for Project Report 80: 20 Pattern will not be applicable to him. There shall be External Examination for Project Report.
4. The syllabus of each course shall be taught in 4 lectures per week during the academic year.
5. The options at Paper No.7 at first & second years are not in progression. The student has choice to opt for any paper at First & Second Year.
